Key Vocabulary

prejudice	A preconceived opinion that is not based on reason or actual experience.
equality	The state of being equal, especially in status, rights, or opportunities.
discrimination	The unjust or prejudicial treatment of different categories of people, especially on the grounds of ethnicity, age, gender, or disability.
stereotypes	A widely held fixed idea of a particular type of person or thing.
citizen	An inhabitant of a particular town, city, or nation.
disability	A physical or mental condition that may limit a person's movements, senses, or activities.
inequality	A difference in size, degree, or circumstances.
poverty	The state of being extremely poor.
nationality	The status of belonging to a particular nation.
culture	The ideas, customs, and social behaviour of a particular people or society.
Sexual orientation:	Whether someone is attracted to people of a different sex (heterosexual), the same sex (homosexual), or both sexes (bisexual).



Amelia Earhart

Amelia Earhart is most famous for being the first female pilot to fly across the Atlantic Ocean by herself. An example of a woman who fought for **gender equality** and against **discrimination**.



Olaudah Equiano

An important African involved in the British movement for the abolition (ending) of the slave trade. He was made a slave when he was a child but was later able to buy his freedom. An example of a man who fought for **equality**.
